General information:

Ages & Stages: Communication development in the first 5 years workshop was conducted on Thursday 14th November 2013 (6-8pm). The workshop was presented by Sarah Elphinstone, Speech Language Pathologist from Flourish Speech Pathology. Registration for the workshop was open to all community members of Childers and surrounding areas. The workshop was a combined initiative of a number of Childers based child-focused organisations and was funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government under the AEDI program.

Structure & Content of workshop:

The workshop was conducted for 2 hours. The content of the workshop included: What is communication? What is the difference between speech and language? What is typical language development at different ages? Examples of speech and language skills in children of different ages. Basic strategies to support communication development in young children. All participants were provided with a disc of resources as well as a paper copy of the presentation.

Evaluation process:

All participants were asked to complete an anonymous evaluation form at the end of the workshop. 22 participants attended the workshop, however 21 evaluation forms were completed (one participant left early due to illness).

Summary statement of results:


The majority of participants were very pleased with the content and structure of the workshop. They found it to be a useful workshop and would recommend the workshop to others.







How useful was the information presented?




Did the workshop meet your learning expectations?




Did you find the workshop interesting?




How well was the workshop facilitated?




Would you recommend the workshop to others?

After attending the workshop, how confident do you feel about your understanding of early communication development in children and your ability to identify children who may not be developing typically?


